* The Advisory Commission on Arts and Culture currently has nine members. The Mayor needs to make enough appointments to ensure that the Commission has the required minimum of five members, but not more than nine members.

** The Juvenile Hearing Board currently has eleven members. The Mayor needs to make enough appointments to ensure that the Board has the required minimum of seven members, with at least one being from each of the six councilmanic districts and one being under the age of 25.

*** The Pawtucket Business Development Corporation currently has twenty-four members. The Mayor needs to make enough appointments to ensure that the Board has the required minimum of twenty-five members, but not more than thirty members.

**** The Pawtucket Hall of Fame Committee currently has eight members. The Mayor needs to make enough appointments to ensure that the Committee has the required minimum of nine members, but not more than fifteen members.
