NOTICE is hereby given that the Planning Board of the Town of Cumberland, Rhode Island pursuant to the provisions of Title 45, Chapter 23 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island & Providence Plantations, as amended, will consider for adoption:

AMENDMENTS OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE TOWN OF CUMBERLAND, RHODE ISLAND.

NATURE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS:

Under Section 4 “Improvement Guarantees”, this amendment more clearly defines “Preconstruction Conference” requirements for developers. A developer will now have to: submit a request for a preconstruction conference; stake out the Limits of Disturbance approved in the Final Plan so that when the conference takes place on site there is no question as to the area in which the developer is authorized to work within; and no work can begin without being authorized by the Town Engineer.

Under Section 2-A (“Definitions”), this amendment defines “exceeding the Limits of Disturbance as specified in the Final Plan” as a Major Change.
