### Question 1

#### AMENDMENT TO THE WOONSOCKET HOME RULE CHARTER – ELECTED SCHOOL COMMITTEE

(Ordinance of the City Council of Woonsocket adopted May 21, 2018)

“Shall the City of Woonsocket Home Rule Charter, Chapter XIV, entitled, “Department of Education,” be amended to provide for the five person school committee of which members are to be elected by the qualified electors of the City for a term of two years or until a successor is duly elected or appointed? (Amends Chapter XIV, Section 2)

Response to the above question shall be “Approve” or “Reject”
