ITEMS ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE: computers, routers, monitors, TVs, laptops, mice, keyboards, ink-jet printers, toner cartridges, wires/cables, microwaves, CD/DVD players, phones, stereo equipment, speakers, play stations, and other electronic gadgetry, lead acid batteries, battery back-ups and auto/ marine batteries- help us keep them out of the landfill!

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR A \$10 DISPOSAL FEE: Laser jet printers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, mini-fridges, and other coolant containing appliances

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

Light bulbs, nickel cadmium and single use batteries, VCR tapes/disks, broken TV tubes, glass containers or microwave trays, Styrofoam, paper, chemicals, aerosol cans, paint or furniture.
