**Working at the polls is a great way for you to become more involved in our democratic process, but time is running out to sign-up!**

**Pawtucket Board of Canvassers pay poll workers between \$150 to \$200, depending on the position, and you must be available to work the day of the election, from 6:00 a.m. until approximately 9:00 p.m.**

## **Poll worker positions available:**

- Supervisors: Seated at the check-in table. They check I.D.'s, ask for name and address, have the voter sign the electronic poll book, and issue a ballot to the voter. \$150
- Clerks: Files most of the paperwork in the polling place, accounts for all the ballots and handles provisional voting and changes of address. \$200
- Wardens: General supervision of the polling place and assists voters with using the voting equipment, including the DS-200 and AutoMark assistance terminal. \$200

**Each poll worker is required to go to a training class!**
