There are changes to Chapter 8. Animals. Article III. Dogs. Division 1. GENERALLY, Division 2. IMPOUNDMENT, and Division 4. RABIES CONTROL:

Add text to Division 1. GENERALLY Sec. 8-71. Definitions. for *Animal Control Officer and Restraint*.

Replace text and fine amounts for Division 2. IMPOUNDMENT Section 8-102. Redemption; fees and fines.

Replace text for Section 8-103. Classification and disposition of unclaimed dogs.

Delete Division 4. RABIES CONTROL. Sec. 8-154 and delete last sentence of text in Sec. 8-155.

All interested persons are invited to attend the Public Hearing and be heard. Modifications to the proposal may occur as a result of the comments received during the hearing or as a result of further study. The application can be reviewed at Town Hall at 181 Howard Hill Road in the office of the Town Clerk during normal business hours.
