

TOWN OF CUMBERLAND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE OF PETITION TO ABANDON A PORTION OF HUNT STREET AND A PORTION OF AN UNNAMED STREET THAT INTERSECTS WITH HUNT STREET WHERE IT TERMINATES TO THE WEST IN THE TOWN OF CUMBERLAND

A petition has been filed with the Cumberland Town Council to declare a portion of Hunt Street has ceased to be useful to the public and that the Town Council therefore abandon said street.

A plan of the proposed abandonment is on file in the office of the Cumberland Town Clerk and on the town's website, www.cumberlandri.org for review by any interested parties. Remonstrant(s) are entitled to be heard before the adoption of the proposed abandonment and the Town Council will give such remonstrant(s) a fair opportunity to make their objections before acting upon such abandonment.

The public hearing will take place on **Wednesday, October 2, 2019, at 7:30 p.m.** at the Cumberland Town Hall in the Town Council Chambers, 45 Broad Street, Cumberland, RI 02864 at which time and place all persons may be heard.
